A big thank you to all who helped with this year's Chicken Bar-B-Q and Flea Market, the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this church-wide fundraiser! There are too many volunteers to mentioned by name (and we don't want to forget anyone, but you all know who you are!) From those who helped unpack and arrange flea market treasures and collect

donations during the sale, everyone who made brownies, or cooked potatoes and chopped onions, to those who helped cook chickens and deliver meals to cars, and all the other other tasks required to make the day a big success, we couldn't have raised over \$4,500 without you! Many hands made light work. We ordered 240 chickens and 100 pounds of cole slaw, and made 200 pounds of potato salad, which all went in to the 448 meals we sold, as well as some leftovers that were sold Sunday morning. We did end up with a bit more potato salad than we needed, but were able to donate about 15 pounds (and a few pounds of cole slaw) to Manna on Main Street.




